

Royal & Ethno Serbia 4 days – 3 nights

Day 1: Arrival day. Belgrade

Transfer Airport – hotel Balkan, accompanied by English speaking guide. In the afternoon sightseeing tour: Princess Ljubica Manor, Patriarchy, Belgrade Fortress, Military Museum, Pobednik monument, "Ruđer Bošković" Observatory, oldest Orthodox Church in Belgrade - Ružica (XVI century), St. Petka Chapel, Nebojša Tower, Emperor Charles Gate, Kalemegdan Park, Gratitude to France monument, Knez Mihailova street (downtown centre),

Dinner – Skadarlija (the Bohemian quarter of the capital). The restaurants in Skadarlija traditionally promote the national cuisine. Restaurant has live music with a traditional repertoire.

Option – after dinner, gipsy night on river boat club.

Day 2: Royal day, Belgrade – Oplenac - Zlatibor Full day sightseeing tour Belgrade – Oplenac with English speaking guide. Tour starts at hotel 09:00. The heart of Serbia, mausoleum of Karadjordjevic dynasty, Ct. George church, monument to King Petar, King Aleksandar's Villa, Queen Maria's Villa. Lunch in a national restaurant. After lunch we will continue our journey through Serbia to Zlatibor, one of the most popular mountains in Serbia. Accommodation and national dinner in hotel Palisad.

Day 3: Ethno day, Zlatibor – Mokra Gora – Sirogojno - Belgrade Full day sightseeing tour with English speaking guide. After breakfast we will go to Sargan Eight train. It is the line which was famous for a curve in the shape of the number 8 that made it possible to climb the steep slopes of the mountains Sargan and Mokra Gora. Lunch at Jatare national restaurant. After lunch visit to Emir Kusturica ethno village at Mokra Gora hill and to Sirogojno – ethno village museum famous in hole world by hand made sweaters – jumpers. Back to Belgrade to the hotel where we will have dinner and accommodation.

Day 4: Departure day, Breakfast. Free time till departure for shoping or sightseeing. Transfer to Belgrade airport, departure
